# CURRICULUM & ASSESSMENT SCHEME



- 100 % Syllabus for the Final Exams
- Weightage of marks is 80 : 20
- 80 – Pen Paper Test & 20 – Internal Assessment
- 3 periodic tests for each subject  
(Pre-Mid Test, Mid Test and post Mid Test followed by Final Exam)

# Revision Test Schedule



- Total 5 Revision Tests will be conducted throughout the year in the month of June, August, Sept, Nov & Dec.
- Students will have to make separate 100 pages notebook per subject for the same.
- Each test will carry 20 marks.
- These marks will not be calculated towards grades in final report card.
- The main aim behind this schedule is to prepare students to appear for final exam with 100% syllabus.

  - Presenting oral reports or summaries; making announcements clearly and confidently.
  - Expressing and arguing a point of view clearly and effectively.
  - Taking active part in group discussions, showing ability to express agreement or disagreement, summarizing ideas, eliciting the views of others, and presenting own ideas, will be assessed.
